Privacy Policy

Hull Thursday Road Club are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purposes of your membership, Hull Thursday Road Club is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

What personal data we hold on you

You may give us information about you by filling in forms at an event or online, or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you join the Club. The information you give us may include your name, date of birth, address, e-mail address, phone number and the name of your first claim Club with which you are registered.

Why we need your personal data

We need your personal data in order to administer your membership, and provide the membership services you sign up to when you join the club. Our lawful basis for processing your personal data is that we have a contractual obligation to you as a member to provide the services you joined for.

Reasons we need to process your data include:

- processing of membership forms and payments;
- sharing data with committee members to provide information about club activities, membership renewals or invitation to social events;
- club newsletter promoting club activity;
- sharing personal data with club coaches or officials to administer training sessions;
- sharing personal data with club team managers to enter events;
- publishing of race and competition results;
- sending out a club survey to improve your experience as a club member;
- sending information about selling club kit, merchandise or fundraising;
- analysing anonymised data to monitor club trends; and
- sharing anonymised data with a funding partner as condition of grant funding e.g. Local Authority.

On occasion, we may collect personal data from non-members, e.g. any non-member participant who fills in an entry form for an activity hosted by the Club. This information will be stored for 52 weeks after an event and then destroyed securely. Our lawful basis for processing data is consent. Therefore, we will also need explicit consent from non-members to process this data, which we will ask for at the point of collecting it.

The club has social media pages on Facebook and Twitter. All members are free to join these pages. If you join one of the Social Media pages, please note that the provider of the social media platforms have their own privacy policies and that the club do not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any personal data on the club social media pages.

How long we hold your personal data

We will hold your personal data on file for as long as you are a member with us. Personal data is updated every year on annual membership forms. Any personal data we hold on you will be securely destroyed after four years of inactivity on that member's account. Your data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the Club. If you choose not to share your personal data with us, we may not be able to register or administer your membership.
